

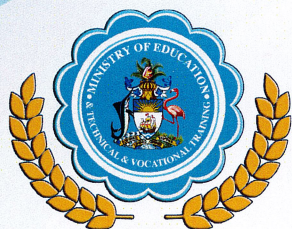

Easy Steps To Renewing The PSSP Scholarship

- Visit the following website: **<https://scholarshipsbahamas.com>** to complete the Scholarships Renewal Form. (This is a must for all renewals.)
- Select the scholarship you are renewing.
- Along with the Renewal Form, you MUST immediately submit the following documents to **pssp@moe.edu.bs** (Only).
 - * Official Transcript (Please have your college/university submit to **pssp@moe.edu.bs**)
 - * Flywire or other wiring instructions bearing student ID information.
 - * Appeal Letter for the following: (If required)
 - Low GPA,
 - Extensions
 - Change of College/University
- On receipt of all materials, the renewal application will be reviewed and processed.

Note: Failure on your part to submit the above materials within the specified timeframe for submission will result in a delay in the processing of your application.

7 Steps To Becoming A Public School Scholar

1. Visit your High School Guidance Department or the Ministry of Education and Technical and Vocational Training Scholarships Website for detailed information.

2. Complete a Career Assessment with your High-School Guidance Department. Review the PSSP Scholarship requirements and the **National Priority List** for Academic and Technical Degree Options.
3. Use the Ministry's Approved Fields of Study and Approved List of Universities/Colleges with Articulation Agreements to apply to at least two colleges/universities for admittance.
4. Prepare for the SAT and ACT if you want to study at US Colleges. Pay attention to expected admission score requirements for the colleges/universities of your choice.
5. Complete an application on the Ministry's Scholarship Website. Remember to upload ALL required documents along with the application.
6. Required Documents:
 - Completed Application
 - Acceptance Letter(s) (All that you have received)
 - Police Certificate
7. Successful PSSP Applicants will be notified upon receipt of the National BGCSE Results.
