The Embassy of the People's Republic of China in the Commonwealth of The Bahamas presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas and has the honour to refer to the meeting between Her Excellency Chinese Ambassador to The Bahamas, Yan Jiarong and Her Excellency Minister of Education and Technical and Vocational Training, Glenys Hanna-Martin in which Ambassador Yan promised more scholarship for The Bahamas from Chinese top universities and Minister Hanna-Martin proposed more extensive background check for more competitive Bahamian candidates.

The Embassy hereby informs the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Ministry of Education that the Chinese Government will offer **4 full scholarships** to Bahamian students in the academic year 2025/2026. The scholarships are divided into 2 categories: **1. The Bilateral Scholarship** enrolls one student, covering international airfare for both the student's initial travel to China and return upon graduation. **2. The Unilateral Scholarship** enrolls 3 students, who will be responsible for their own travel expenses to China. Both categories cover mainly the students' tuition fees, accommodation, living expenses and medical insurance.

The Embassy kindly requests the Ministries to widely disseminate the

aforementioned information including publicizing the online application portal <http://www.campuschina.org> where applicants are free to choose from China's top universities and scholarship programs according to their major.

Enclosed please find the Instructions of the Chinese Scholarship Council (CSC) Online Application System for International Students, Requirements for the 2025/2026 Chinese Government Scholarship Application and Foreigner Physical Examination Form. For more information, please refer to the website <http://www.campuschina.org>.

It would be highly appreciated if the Ministry could confirm the scholarship candidates and provide the Embassy with **a recommended list of 4 candidates by 14 February, 2025**. The Embassy will make final recommendations upon receiving the Ministry's shortlist.

The Embassy of the People's Republic of China avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas the assurances of its highest consideration.
